Effects of domestic violence on children |

As many as ten million children and adolescents witness violence between their parents or caregivers each year. This kind of violence is called domestic violence or intimate partner violence. The US Department of Justice defines domestic violence as "a pattern of abusive behavior in any relationship that is used by one partner to gain or maintain power and control over another intimate partner."

10 million children are exposed to adult domestic violence each year. One researcher has estimated conservatively that at least 10 to 20 percent of children are exposed to intimate partner violence annually, with as many as one-third exposed at some point during childhood or adolescence.

Rates of Child Abuse and Child Exposure to Domestic Violence

Recommended public health approaches to the treatment of children exposed to violence include specific training for professionals working with families experiencing trauma,

developmentally appropriate interventions for children in programs addressing domestic violence, and programs that address the emotional needs of children living under circumstances where they are likely to experience violence (e.g., poverty, domestic violence, substance abuse, neighborhood violence).

One in seven (14.2%) children and young people under the age of 18 will have lived with domestic violence at some point in their childhood. 61.7% of women in refuge on the Day to Count 2017 had children (aged under 18) with them (Women's Aid, 2018 – data from Women's Aid Annual Survey 2017).

domestic violence are more likely to be affected by violence as adults – either as victims or perpetrators.⁵ Children who are exposed to violence in the home are denied their right to a safe and stable home environment. Many are suffering silently, and with little support.

Behind Closed Doors The Impact of Domestic Violence on ...

Males exposed to domestic violence as children are more likely to engage in domestic violence as adults, and females are more likely to be victims as adults.
